Our Services

- **In-home light housekeeping and errands service.** Employees are bonded and insured and provide services such as:



- vacuuming
- mopping floors
- dusting
- clean bathrooms
- clean kitchen
- laundry
- bed linens changed

Hourly rate based on sliding fee scale. In addition, our employees can run simple errands for the senior such as running to drug store or grocery store.

- **Foster Grandparent Program.**

Seniors age 60 and over volunteer in various community settings to work with special needs children. Receive training as well as a Federal volunteer stipend, meal and travel reimbursement.

Activities and Programs

- **Transportation** to and from the senior center, grocery shopping and recreational trips



- **Recreational activities** such as arts and crafts, bingo, trips, cards and exercise

- **Educational activities** such as computers, wellness activities and community presentations on topics of interest



- Well balanced noon **meal** provided weekdays by Lucas County Senior Nutrition

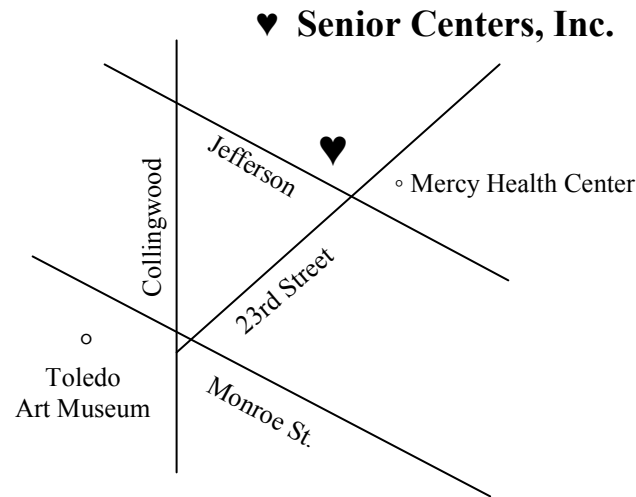
